## Avatar: The Last Airbender Escape Room FAQs

What ages is the escape room aimed at?

This escape room is designed for elementary- and middle school-aged children although it can be enjoyed by all ages.

What is the maximum group size?

The escape room, due to its size, can take a maximum of eight people.

What is the minimum group size?

The minimum group size is two people.

Can my child and their friends do the escape room alone?

Teenagers 13+ can do the escape room alone or in a group. Any child 12 or under will need an adult present in the room with them. The adult counts as one of the participants.

How long is the escape room?

You will have thirty minutes to complete your escape room. Due to the fact that there are multiple bookings during the day, at thirty minutes your group will need to leave the space, whether or not you have solved all of the clues. However, when you have five minutes left, your escape room host will provide you with hints to help you finish, if you would like.

What happens if I show up late to my escape room?

You will still be admitted to the escape room. However, because there are multiple bookings a day, you will have less time to complete the escape room, as your session will still end thirty minutes after your original start time.

Do I need to know about Avatar to complete the escape room?

You do not. All of the information that you need to solve the puzzles will be inside the escape room. That being said, if you do know a bit about the Avatar: The Last Airbender animated series you may be able to complete the room faster.

Do I need to dress up in my best Avatar outfit?

You do not, but you are definitely welcome to if you would like!

Do I need to bring anything with me to the escape room?

You do not need to bring anything.
